The Parks and Recreation Department has been offered the donation of a bench at Sar-Ko-Par Trails Park with a plaque.

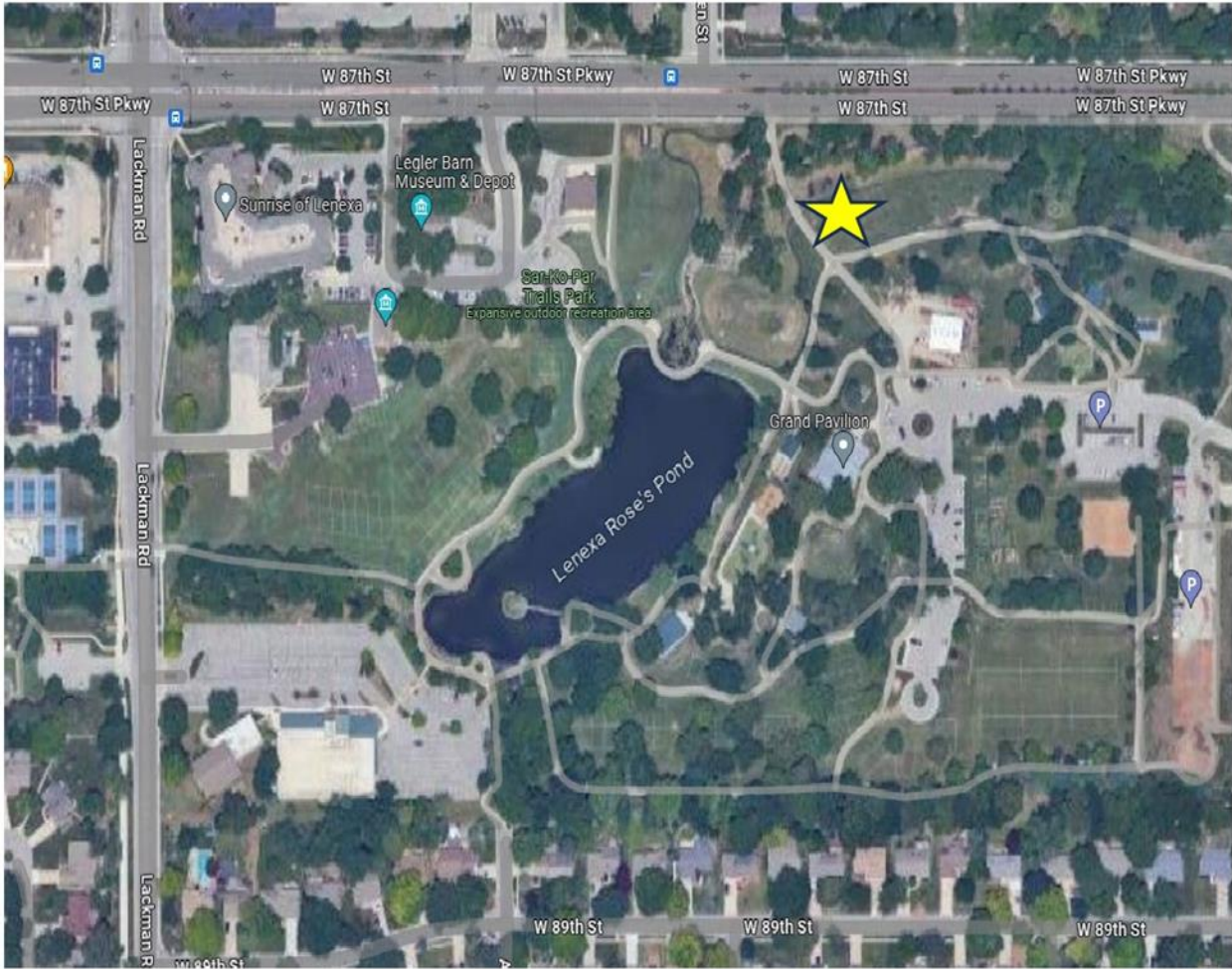

This request is from Dave McDermott to donate a new bench at Black Hoof Park along the trail. Mr. McDermott chose this location because he and his wife enjoyed walking the trail around Lake Lenexa and really loved the view of the lake from the area near the boardwalks. The two would enjoy the birds in the marsh and the sparkle of light off the water.
