The Parks and Recreation Department has been offered the donation of a bench at Little Mill Creek Trail with a plaque.

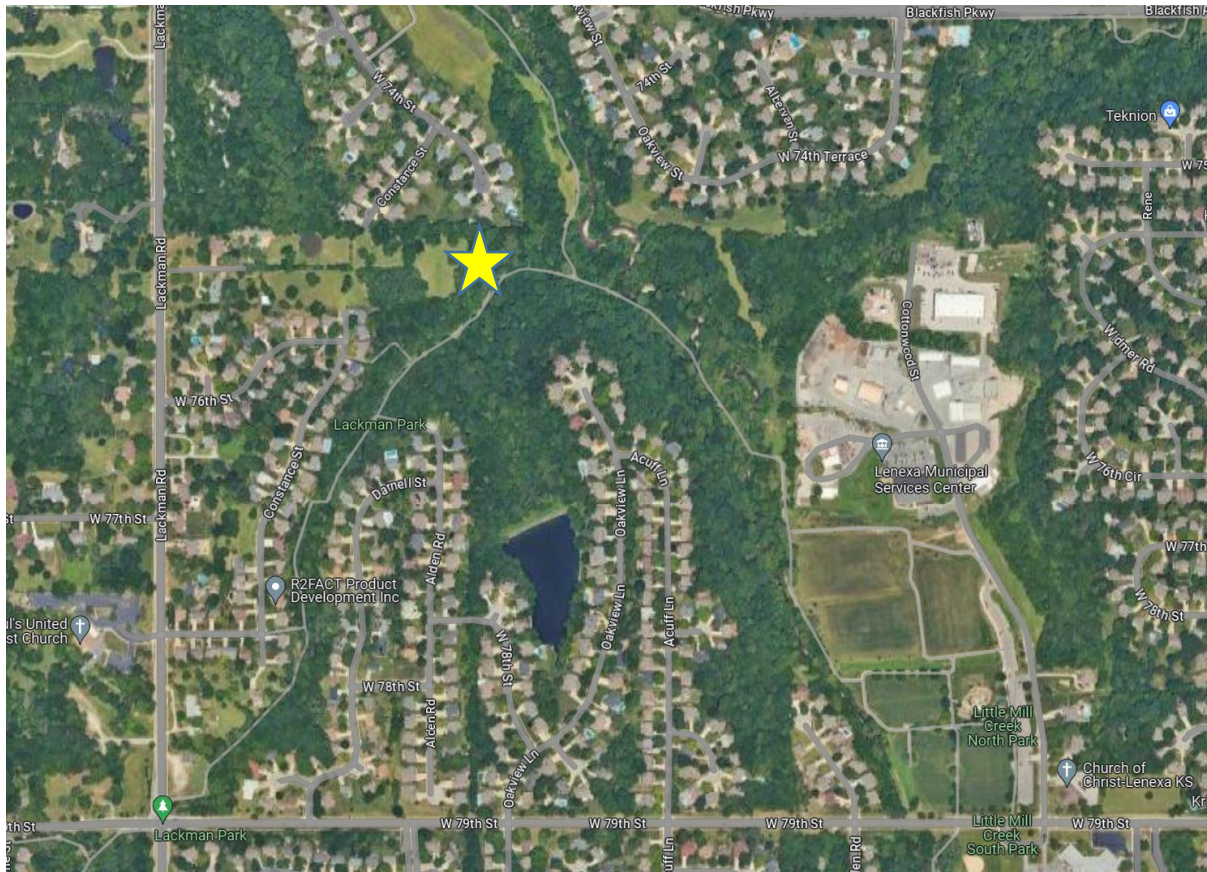
